
Following the worship service, we will be having a taco bar with so many fixings.

#### MAY DEVOTION

What is it like to start something new? Scary? Terrifying? Exciting? All of them! Can you imagine starting something new that would change the face of the Christian world? That is exacting what happened in Acts 1 & 2, also known as the "Birthday of the Church." It is described as, "there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting. Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them." (Acts 2:2-3). I don't know about you, but this is something that sounds extremely scary! A visual of the Holy Spirit. Normally, when we think of the Holy Spirit coming down, we think of the dove and a light, like when Jesus was baptized. But here, it is fire. 


